Wrablers Musical Director

Wrablers are a 12-member mixed voice acapella choir who meet to rehearse fortnightly (on Tuesdays, 7-9pm) at a central London location. In the six weeks prior to performances, we meet weekly.

We perform twice a year, usually in June/July and November/December and perform a mixture of songs ranging from pop, through jazz to folk and world music. We are a secular choir.

We are member-led, but would like to change this arrangement to have a musical director help us work on our technique and performance skills on a regular basis.

The director would ideally:

- 1. Attend rehearsals regularly
- 2. Allocate parts for songs based on the membership at the time
- 3. Introduce songs to the group and have a view on how the song should be performed
- 4. Lead the group to ensure that the songs are performed according to the agreed vision for the song
- 5. Help the group to work on any sections of the song that are problematic
- 6. Help the group work on performance skills

The director may wish to:

- 1. Suggest and introduce new songs to the repertoire
- 2. Work with individuals on their vocal skills
- 3. Suggest new members for the group based on the membership of the group and potential vacancies
- 4. Attend performances and conduct the group

The group will continue to

- 1. Select the repertoire
- 2. Take responsibility for learning songs by ear from MP3 files generated by musical notation software prior to rehearsal
- 3. Be responsible for all group admin (emails, organising venues, performances etc)
