BASS / TENOR:

ALTO / SOPRANO:

opened and she's let him in opened and she's let him in

Oh and she's rose up and she let him in and she's kissed her true love cheek and chin And she's took him between the sheets again and she's opened and let him in

ALL: OH-OH-OH-OH

CHORUS 3:

Then she's blessed the rainy night - Cold and hailey windy night Oh then she's blessed the rainy night (that she) opened and she let him in oh

MIDDLE 8

TENOR / ALTO / SOP: Cold rainy night x 7 **BASS:**

And so our story turns – as folklore would have for our lovers

To the star crossed and the spurned - and the women who too soon are mothers

But was the soldier so feckless? Was the sorrowful maiden foresworn?

Forgotten stories lay restless -

TENOR / ALTO: wait in the eye of the storm......

BASS / SOPRANO: as they wait in the eye of the storm.....

VERSE 4:

BASS / TENOR:

B: Stay with me – stay with me – stay with me

T: Stay with me – stay with me – stay with me

Oh no my dear you're not for me - so fare thee well forever

ALTO / SOPRANO:

O soldier soldier wont you stay with me and soldier - won't you marry me Oh no.....so fare - thee - well...

CHORUS 4:

VERSE 5:

BASS / TENOR:

<u>He's jumped up out of the bed – put his hat all on his head</u>
<u>Gone away - with her – maidenhead – mother - has heard the din (OH-OH-OH)</u> **ALTO / SOP:**

Oh - and he's jumped up - out o-of the bed and he's put hi-is hat all - on his head And he's - **gone** away with her - maidenhead and her mother - has heard the din **ALL: OH - OH - OH**

CHORUS 5:

Then she's cursed the rainy night - cold and hailey windy night
Oh then she's cursed the rainy night (that she) opened and she let him in oh

OUTRO:

TENOR and ALTO: Let me in – let me in – let me in (on a loop until*) (NOT staggered)

BASS: You never knew why I pushed you away

SOP: I never knew why you just couldn't stay

BASS: You never knew the secrets that I keep

SOP: I never knew where rainy nights you slept

BASS: You never knew why I had to leave your bed

SOP: I never knew if you were living or were dead

BASS: You never knew just how hard it was to leave you, on that fateful

SOP: I never knew, what happened to you on that
